

TUBZZ Cleaning and Operating Instructions

Dear Homeowner,

Thank you for purchasing your bathtub from Custom-Jetted Tubzz. We appreciate your business and look forward to improving your bathing experience for years to come. We design our bathtubs to be durable, clean and quiet with minimal upkeep required to retain these qualities. Refer to this guide as needed to maintain the elegant look and a clean bathing experience and for information on using your tub.

Cleaning and Maintaining Your Acrylic Tub Surface

- Your tub surface is made with the highest quality, most durable tub material available-- acrylic. Acrylic is a solid, non-porous surface which prevents discoloration, yellowing and fading. The color all the way through the acrylic sheet, it is not painted or sprayed on, and therefore cannot be rubbed off.
- Because of the non-porous nature of acrylic, its surface prevents dirt from accumulating resists stains. Cleaning is easy since mold and dirt cannot penetrate its surface.
- Simply wash with soap and water. Rinse well and dry with a soft, clean cloth. If using a household cleaner, be sure it is non-abrasive and recommended by the manufacturer for use on acrylic.
- Clean grease, oil, paint and ink stains with isopropyl (rubbing) alcohol.
- Minor scratches that may have occurred during construction can be removed by buffing lightly with a clean cloth and an automotive buffing compound (small amounts are available free through Tubzz). Deep scratches and/or chips from fallen tile, hammers, etc., can be repaired for a small fee by contacting Tubzz.

Cleaning, Maintaining, and Using Your Self Draining Whirlpool Jetting System

- Our new "V Jets" combined with rigid PVC allow for the best drainage of any jetted bathtub available. For longer lasting and cleaner jets, follow these steps monthly: fill the tub with cold water, use some dishwasher detergent, run the jets for a couple minutes and drain the tub. We recommend using SeaKlear. Spa jet cleaner in lieu of detergent every 6-8 months as needed. One bottle provides 10 treatments, costs \$19.99 and can be found at Tubzz.
- Our tubs are self-draining. However, soap residue from bubble bath, shampoo, etc., can sometimes remain behind. This is why we recommend the occasional treatments mentioned above.
- Each jet is adjustable. Simply turn the jet cover left or right and jet flow will adjust up or down. The nozzle inside the jet cover can be adjusted to angle jet flow in the desired direction.
- Each jet cover in your tub is removable. We recommend removing these covers and cleaning them occasionally. Clean them by hand or on the top rack of the dishwasher.
- See further cleaning details on each type of jet.
- To remove covers for cleaning simply slide a flathead screwdriver between jet cover and tub surface. Turn screwdriver and the jet cover will come off. To return the jet cover, simply snap back into place.
- Turbo system jets are generally located higher in the tub near your neck and upper back. These jets are controlled by a valve located near the top edge of the tub. Point valve forward to activate turbo system jets and point backwards to turn them off.
- These jets can also be removed for cleaning. Sit facing the jet and use your index fingers and thumbs of both hands to turn the jets counterclockwise ¼ turn.
- DO NOT TURN CLOCKWISE TO REMOVE JETS.



- To replace jets after cleaning turn clockwise ¼ turn.
- You can control the amount of air that will come out of each jet using by adjusting the air controller located near the top of the tub. If this controller is turned all the way to the right (off position), only water will come out of the jets. To achieve maximum air and jet power, turn the controller all the way to the left. Depending on the number of jets, there might be multiple air controllers.
- Turn on/off tub with button located near the top of your tub. This is a non-electronic button. When the button is pushed, air is sent to the motor via a red air hose to activate the motor. If the motor does not turn on, check if the red hose is connected to the motor. If it still doesn't turn on, contact an electrician for the location of your GFCI reset button.

Using the Air Systems in Your Therapeutic Bathtub

- Push on/off button to turn on and adjust blower. Pushing it once will turn the blower on, and start on the (1) High setting. Pushing it twice will switch the setting to (2) Medium. A third push switches to (3) Low, a fourth push changes to (4) Wave Mode, and a fifth push will turn the blower (5) off. A purge cycle that lasts 2-3 minutes will automatically begin twenty minutes after the blower has been turned off.

How the In-Line Heater Works

- The heater has been designed to enhance the enjoyment of your whirlpool bathtub. Once filled, the warm, relaxing temperature of the whirlpool bath is constantly maintained by a built-in thermostat as long as the pump is operating.
- In-line heaters are pressure activated. When you turn the pump on, the heater is automatically activated.
- A "heater on" indicator light is illuminated while the heater is actively heating the water.

Syllent Pump

Feel the embrace of the warm water around you with our Syllent Pump. This pump ensures the temperature of your bath water maintains every degree perfectly as you soak. The Syllent Pump can be enjoyed in our WaterFlow Hydrotherapy system while providing a heating system through green energy.

Hot Soak
